## **OMS Young Persons Worker - Internship**

**Job Based:** UK Wide

### **Role Summary:**

To promote and engage under 25's in the ministry and missions work of OMS UK

**Hours & Salary:** 35 Hours per week. Funding: Combination (Personal Support & Pooled Resources)

**2 Year fixed tem**

**Responsible to:** UK Executive Director

### **Summary of essential role functions:**

- Proactively generate meetings and speaking engagements with Young Peoples groups at Churches, Missions Conferences, colleges and other organisations. Acting as the youth representative for OMS UK
- Generate increasing awareness of OMS especially amongst young people, who have not worked with us before or who may not be aware of OMS missions work worldwide
- Arrange and promote young people's meetings for those who have been involved short term or long term mission opportunities with OMS in the past.
- Be willing to encourage and build young people's prayer meetings across the UK, with particular focus within Northern Ireland.
- Potentially lead a team on a short term missions trip – following probationary period and suitable training
- Raise the OMS UK profile across new media, Facebook, twitter etc and assist in production of communications literature aimed at young people
- To integrate into and learn the different aspects of the Missions work of a missionary charity.

### **Essential Criteria**

- Genuine desire to serve in mission with a passion for worldwide outreach
- Willingness to travel as appropriate
- Excellent interpersonal and presentational skills
- Willingness to engage in cross cultural work
- Self-motivated, organised and a strong team player
- Computer literate with MS Office, internet, facebook and twitter etc
- Able to demonstrate understanding and acceptance of the OMS statement of faith and the Holiness Movement
- To be actively involved in the life and witness of your own congregational life

## **Desirable criteria**

- Experience of overseas mission work
- Theological training and/or experience of working with young people in Church.
- Experience of leading or hosting young people's gatherings

## **Awareness:**

To be a self-motivator, going into the community seeking opportunities to speak at or visit various meetings through existing and new contacts, this may be through personal relationships, mail drops or through colleges. Assist in following up enquiries about serving with the mission, both at home and abroad and present OMS to schools and universities, at Bible colleges, CU's and SU groups.

## **Interest**

Your chief aim is to galvanise and engage young people to serve home or abroad, short term or long term, in mission opportunities with OMS UK, through all means mentioned above. We would also encourage joint mission opportunities and development of cross organisational working with other agencies, where appropriate.

## **Involvement**

Challenge young people individuals, Churches and CU groups to engage with and support the work of OMS through giving, prayer and going. Ultimately the Lord calls, but we have the responsibility to make the needs known.

## **Missionary Support**

In liaison with the Personnel Officer and Executive Director, maintaining some contact with those recruited, whilst here and overseas and when they complete their service. You may also be involved in some induction and preparation for young people's service overseas.

## **Administration**

You are required to keep records of meetings and receipts on a monthly basis. To develop and maintain a database of supporting churches and contacts generated. Some administration of conferences and other promotional events, when required.

## **CONDITIONS**

The hours will be 35 hours per week worked on a flexi or rolling basis as the role demands. There will be 20 days holiday per year plus bank holidays and a period between Christmas and the New Year when the office closes.

*There is a genuine occupational requirement for this role to be held by a committed Christian, able to agree with the OMS statement of belief. They must be able to offer appropriate Christian support to applicants, colleagues and supporters, and be able to proactively take part in organisational events such as prayer meetings and conferences and represent OMS to supporters, enquirers as an Evangelical Christian mission organisation.*

They are not to be construed as an exhaustive list of all responsibilities, duties and skills requires of personnel in this position. All personnel may be required to perform duties outside of their normal responsibilities from time to time, as required.
