



LATIN AMERICA

The Latin America region has a vision to transform lives in dynamic communities. As an intern, you'll serve in your area of focus while being part of localized summer ministry experiences. You'll also be poured into by a team of missionaries as you learn more about your gifts and passions. Our hope for the internship experience is you will grow in your relationship with God, expand your skill set, be more prepared to disciple people from other cultures, and perhaps discern a long-term call to missions and ministry.

Mexico Openings:

Discipleship and Mentor Intern: Use your unique skills alongside the MEFI (homeless ministry) team to help disciple and mentor homeless young people who come to the drop-in center. These relationships will be facilitated through group activities, one-on-one interaction, and job skills training.

Outreach and Training Intern: Serve with Satura Mexico, primarily alongside our Satura kids and youth teams, to help facilitate and train individuals to reach their communities for Christ. You will serve by facilitating formal training sessions, vacation Bible schools, youth camps, and Bible clubs.

Seminary Professor Intern: Work with the SEMBIMEX (Mexico Biblical Seminary) team to offer introductory courses through the Basic Ministry and Integration Seminar program. Depending on your length of stay, education level, and Spanish competence, opportunities for teaching basic seminary courses could also be a possibility.

Colombia Openings:

Media and Communications Intern: With a team, use your skills in photography, videography, video editing, production, writing, and design to tell the story of ministry impact and drive mission engagement for the OMS Colombia field.

English Camp Intern: Provide English camps to Spanish-speaking Colombians who are learning English, specifically to Colombians called to serve as missionaries and to Colombians in the local church as an outreach to youth.

Discipleship through Sports Intern: Serve with a local soccer ministry to connect with Colombian youth and encourage them to follow Christ.



During your time on Embark, you will:

- Serve with One Mission Society, a global mission organization.
- Build relationships with youth and young adults.
- Receive mentorship from experienced missionaries.
- Work alongside a team of other like-minded OMS summer interns.
- Expand and hone your skill set.
- Grow in your ministry approach to evangelism, discipleship, and communicating your testimony.

Mid-June to Mid-August 2022

Mexico: You'll live in Mexico City at the seminary guest apartments or a missionary home.

Colombia: You'll live in Medellín, Colombia, at the seminary or a rented apartment.

The cost:

- **Mexico:** \$3,000 + Travel Expenses
- **Colombia:** \$4,300-\$5,300 + Travel Expenses

This is a volunteer internship that requires raising financial support through ministry partners for travel and other expenses.
